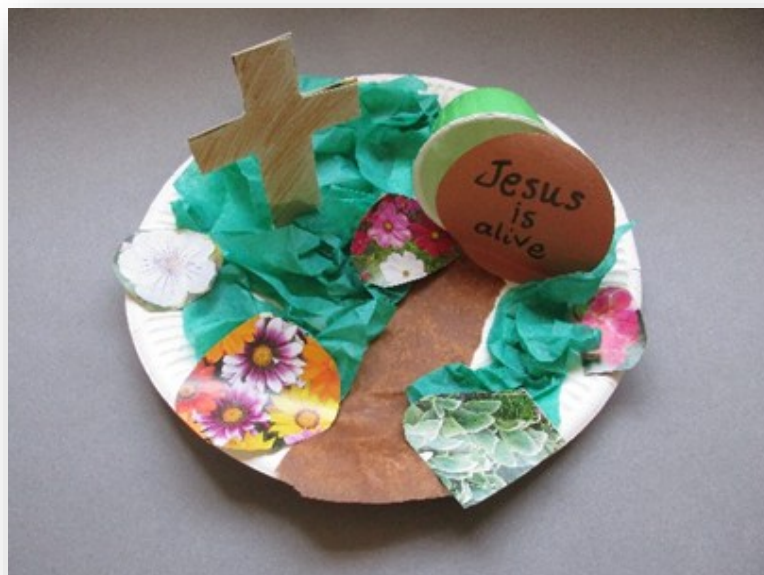
MINIATURE EASTER GARDENS
